

# Breakout Sessions

1. **Youth Worker Roundtable**- Leaders only (Anson McMahon)  
This is an informal session with Anson for adult youth workers and older students interested in youth ministry.
2. **Worship** (Shaun Bennett from Julian Drive)  
Shaun is back again this year to talk about worship. If you missed this session last year, you won't want to miss it again.
3. **Mission: Haiti** (Shane Bowers & Josh Seagraves from Julian Drive)  
God gave the guys from Julian Drive an incredible opportunity to minister to the people of Haiti during and after the earthquake that devastated the country about a year ago. Come see & hear about how God is working through this tragedy.
4. **For Guys Only** (Brian Puckett)  
Join Brian for a time of guy talk – no girls allowed. Brian will explore topics that affect guys. Enough said.
5. **For Girls Only** ()  
You know you have things to talk about that the boys just don't get. \_\_\_\_ will share with the girls about self image, maintaining purity and honoring God in their relationships.
6. **Tough Questions** (Jerry Kennedy)  
Students will be allowed to ask any Bible related question they want. Dr. Kennedy will also come prepared with some standard tough questions that all Christians deal with.
7. **Real Life** (Marni Laughman & Courtnie Harris)

8. **Sharing Jesus 1-on-1** (Mike Reed)

9. **God in the Storm: Dealing with Hard Times** (Mike Reed)  
Mike will share his testimony of how God has brought him through times of loss. Subjects will include the death of a loved one, divorce of parents, and God's strength.
10. **Following God's Direction** (Earl "the Pearl" Perry)  
Ever wonder what in the world God wants you to do? Earl will share from the Word and his own experience about how to discern God's will and how to follow it.
11. **Discovering Your Spiritual Gift** (Brad Hughes & Danny Smith)
